*Those with speaking parts can either stand separately from the choir or can remain in the choir while projecting their parts to the audience. Be sure that a microphone can pick up each voice. Practice having the performers speak clearly, slowly, and loudly.*

*As the concert begins, sailors stand on stage as in a typical performance. The captain can stand next to the sailors or in front, but turn toward the audience when speaking.*

**Captain**     Another year of Patch Club has come to a close. Sailors, Let's talk about some of the things we've learned this year.

**Music**        (Sailors sing.) *Treasure of My Heart* or *Richer than a King*

**Sailor 4**       (*holding a piggy-bank*) What are you doing with your piggy bank?

**Sailor 5**       I'm going to deposit all my money in the bank. In a few years, (*arms outstretched*) I'll be rich!

**Sailor 4**       Your piggy bank is going to make you rich? It can't hold *that* much money!

**Sailor 3**       But we learned in Patch Club this year that you *can* be rich in a different way, (Sailor 4).

- Sailor 5** I know what you're talking about! I can be rich in spiritual ways.
- Sailor 3** Right! Each time we do something for God and not for ourselves, we are adding to our heavenly treasures.
- Sailor 4** And the Bible tells us that the things we think are so important on this earth are all going to pass away.
- Girls:** (*Recite Matthew 6:20*) "But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- Boys** (*Recite Matthew 6:21*) "For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also."
- Music:** (Sailors sing.) *It's All Gonna Pass Away* or *Promised Land*
- Sailor 6** I'm a little worried!
- Sailor 7** What's wrong, (Sailor 6)? Is there something I can do to help?
- Sailor 6** I've been hearing about lots of bad things that have been happening lately all over the world—earthquakes, and wars, and lots of other things.
- Sailor 7** I know what you mean, but don't you remember hearing about all the people in the Bible that God cared for? We don't have to worry or be afraid because God promises that He will care for us, too. He's the same today as He was then.
- Sailor 6 Thanks, (Sailor 7). I guess I need to remember to look to God because He's in control of everything. When I'm worried, instead of looking around me I'll just look up!
- Music** (Sailors sing.) *Look Up!* or *How Can I Fear?*
