






TAKE THE MESSAGE


SISSY'S PICCOLO

THE SUPER SAILOR SAXOPHONE

The saxophone is called a woodwind instrument, but it is actually made out of brass. There are seven instruments in the family of saxophones. The mouthpiece is very much like the clarinet.

The saxophone was invented by a man named Adolpho Sax.
He lived from 1814 to 1894.
He studied flute and clarinet and wanted to improve on the two instruments. With the saxophone he was able to combine the single reed mouthpiece of the clarinet with a redesigned tube. The new shape led to simpler keywork with the fingers, as in playing the oboe.


